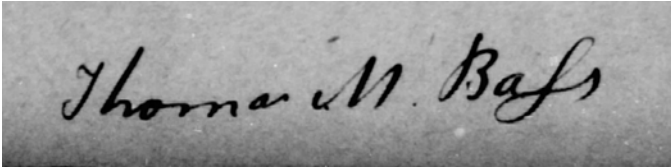


BASS, T. M. Forage Supplier

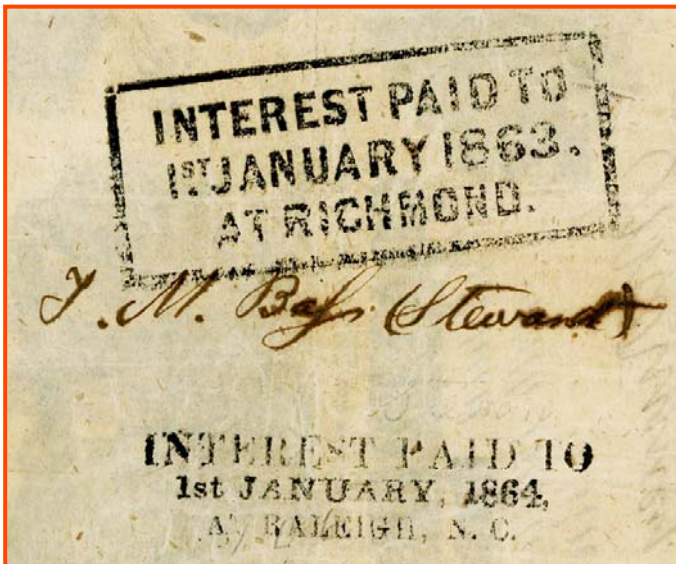
Five documents are found in a file for Thomas Mitchell Bass in the National Archives files for Citizens. The endorsement on the Treasury note is a good match to the only signature in the National Archives files.

The endorsement contains the interesting notation “(Steward),” but there is no reference in the file to Bass as a steward, only as a supplier of oats on a voucher dated June 30, 1863, at Lynchburg, Virginia. The voucher was prepared by Capt. John W. Woodson, AQM, an officer posted in the City of Lynchburg. Capt. Woodson’s files contain many telegrams and letters dealing with the supply of corn and forage to the army.
