

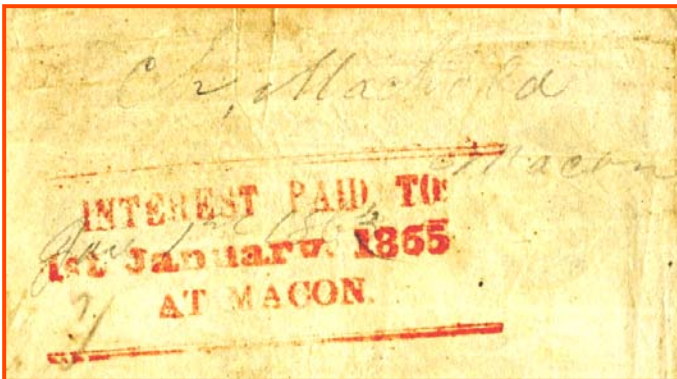
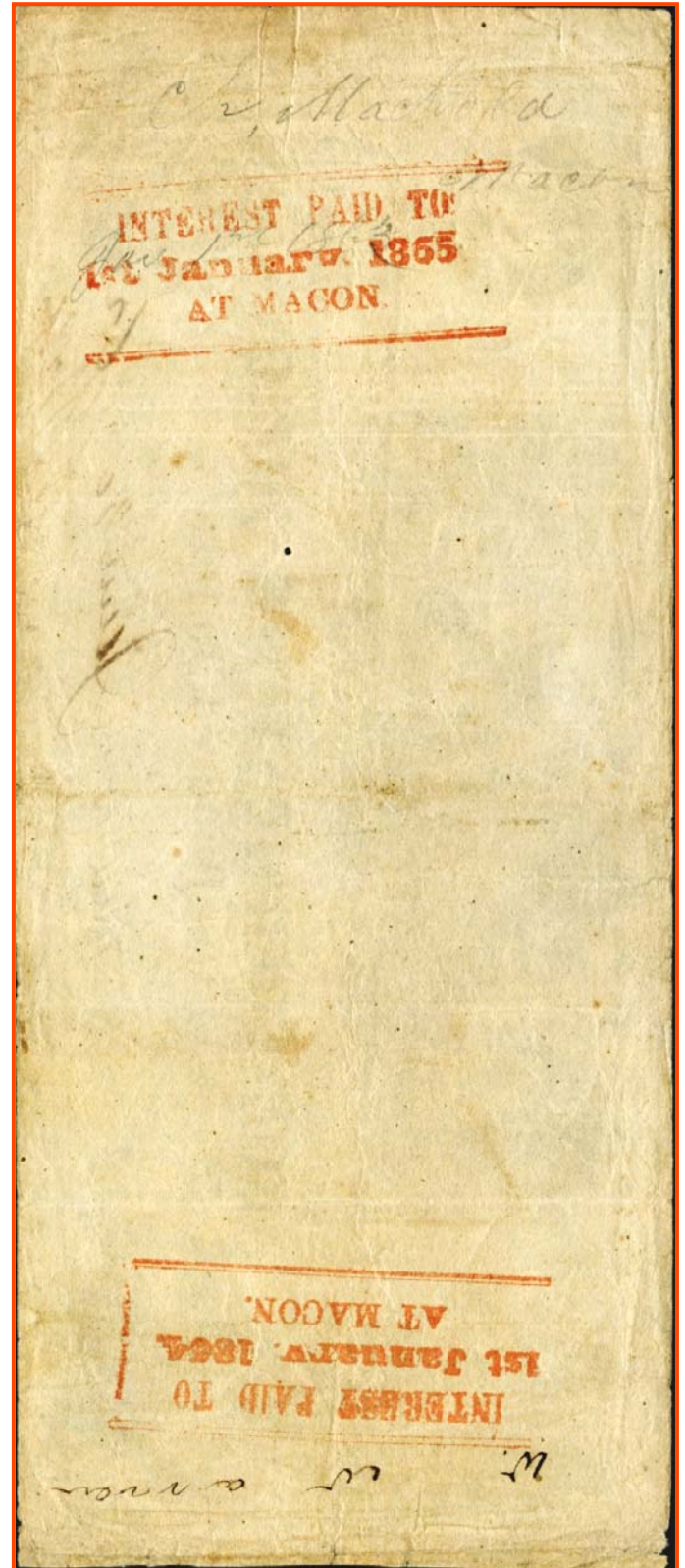
MACHOLD, C. Supplier to C. S. Laboratories

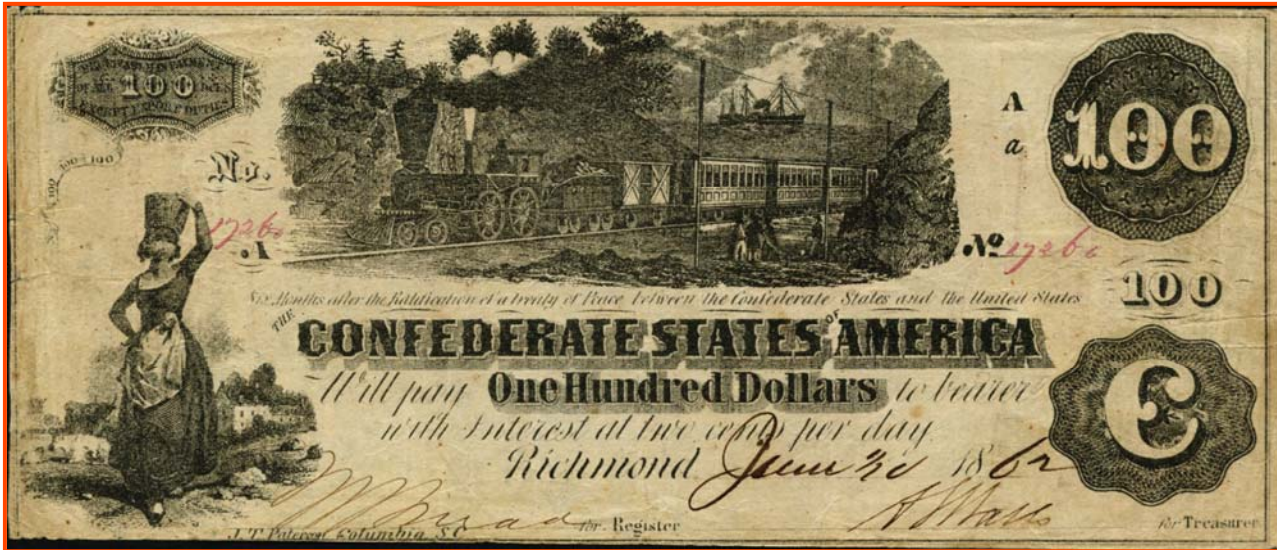
Four documents are found in a file for C. Machold in the National Archives files for Citizens. The Treasury note has two endorsements, one by W. Warren, for whom no information could be found in the files for Officers, Miscellaneous, or Citizens, and another which reads "C. Machold, Macon, Jan 1st 1863," which correlates well with the two red Interest Paid stamps at Macon, Georgia.

Only two requisitions were found in Machold's file. A requisition dated October 14th, 1863, listed 16 bundles of matches for a price of \$2.00, which was paid by Capt. H. T. Massengale, Paymaster. The requisition was approved by Maj. J. W. Mallet, the Superintendent of the Confederate States Laboratories at Macon, Georgia. The signature of Machold on this requisition is an excellent match to the endorsement on the Treasury note.

Another requisition dated May 9th, 1864 at Macon, Georgia, listed the work of "digging a well. Blind School Hospital. 92 1/2 feet deep @ \$2.50 [per foot], 75 feet curbing @ \$1.00 [per foot]," for a total of \$306.25. The Surgeon in Charge, Geo. F. Cooper, wrote: "I certify upon honor that the work was absolutely necessar, & that it was performed according to contract, and in a workmanship-like manner." This requisition was signed by Maj. J. G. Michailoffsky, Quartermaster. Of significant interest is the signature at the bottom of this form, "Mrs. C. Machold," making this endorsement very likely the first known example from a woman.
