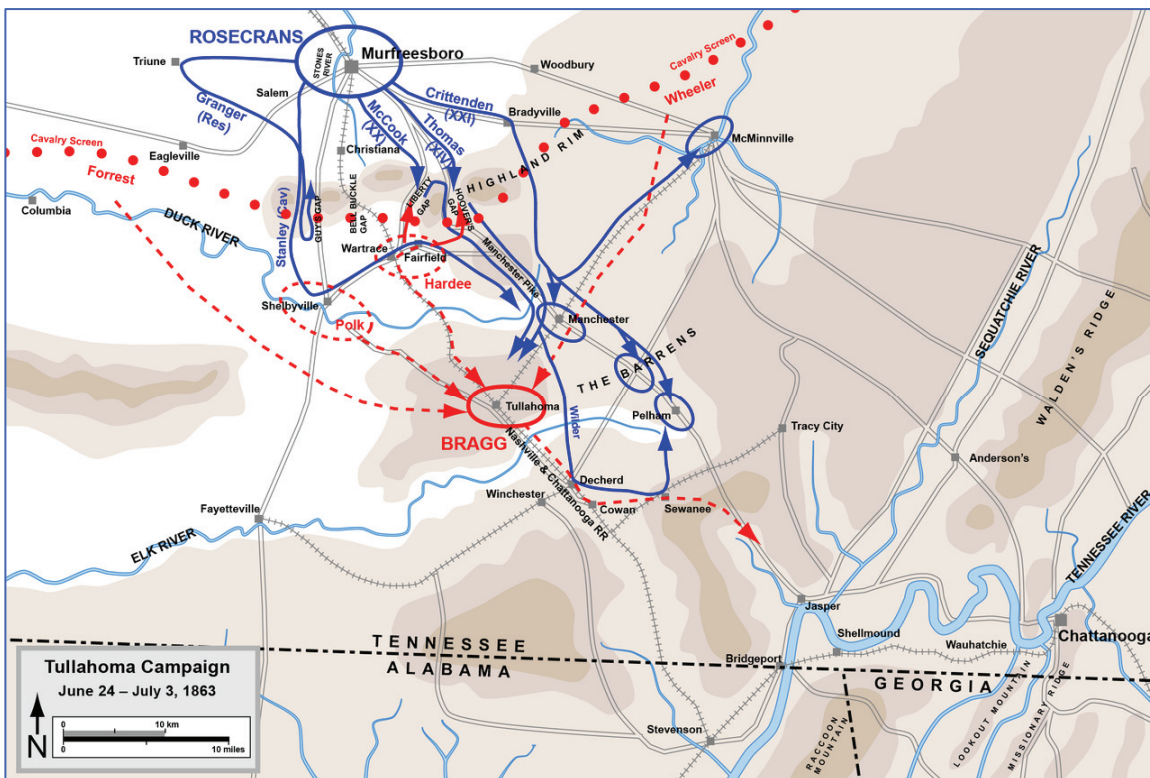
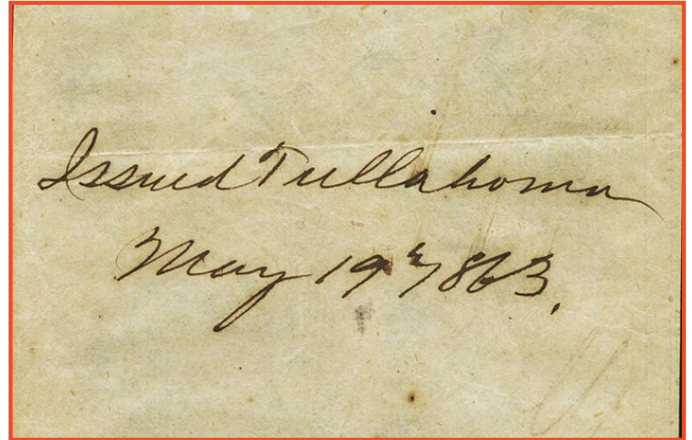
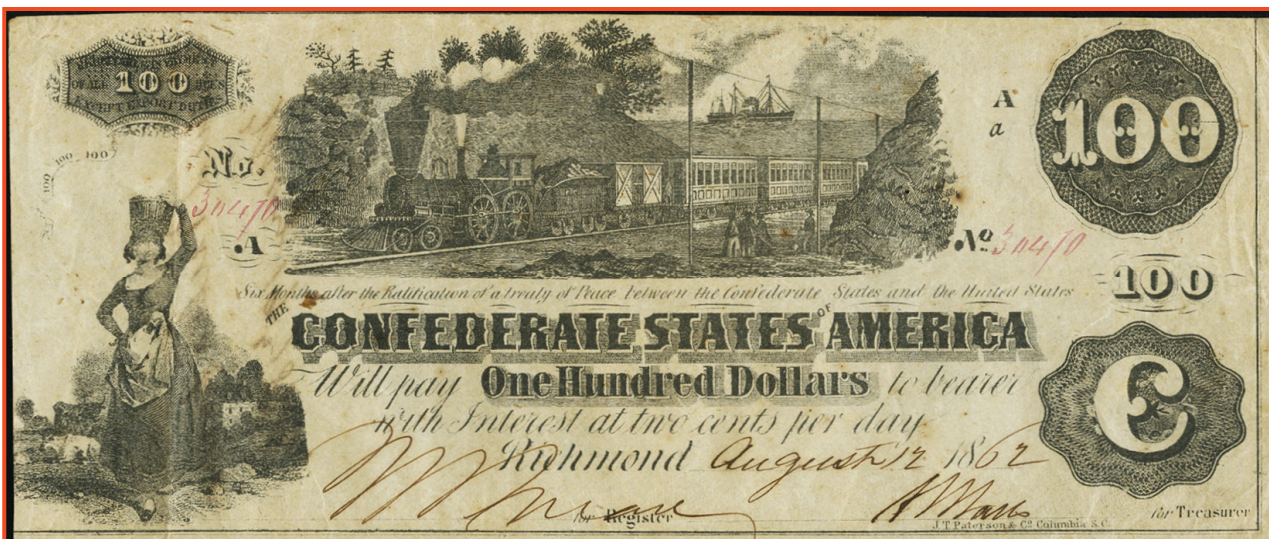


TULLAHOMA, TENNESSEE

Tullahoma, Tennessee, resided on the Nashville and Chattanooga Rail Road about 40 miles northwest of Chattanooga in May of 1863 when this note was issued. The note is simply endorsed: "Issued Tullahoma, May 19th 1863." General Braxton Bragg's Army of Tennessee was engaged by the Union Army of the Cumberland a short time later in June with disastrous results for Bragg. We do not know who issued this note, but we know that the Confederate units in Bragg's Army were: Polk's Corps, Hardee's Corps, Wheeler's Cavalry Corps, and Forrest's Cavalry Division. ■ McNeil
